

Welcome to Juniper Hills

To ensure an enjoyable stay for all, we request our guests observe these sensible camp rules.

1. All guests are expected to conduct themselves in an adult manner at all times with consideration for fellow campers.
2. All persons and pets must be registered. Pets must be kept on a leash or confined to your site at all times. Absolutely no pets are allowed in any camp buildings or pond area. A copy of your pet's vaccination record must be on file and they must wear a pet band around their collar. The first pet band is free and it is \$5.00 for each additional.
 - a) *All persons who do not have pre-registered credentials will need to check in at the campground office.*
 - b) *Guests may walk to all areas of the campground but vehicles are limited to the specific campground section where owner's campsite is located.*
3. ALL PERSONS MUST wear a Juniper Hills wristband when on Juniper Hills Campground property during race weeks.
4. All camping units and vehicles must fit on the site assigned (**Only 1 camping unit per site!**). You may not encroach on roads or adjoining sites. Roadways and driving lanes must remain open at all times. For obvious safety and security reasons, any vehicle on Juniper Hills property without a proper Juniper Hills vehicle tag listing owner's correct license plate number, or any vehicle improperly parked in areas other than the assigned camping space of the vehicle owner, will be towed at the owner's expense.
5. Rates include campground admission for 2 adults, 1 camping unit, and 1 motor vehicle. The camping unit and vehicle must both fit on one site or an additional site must be purchased. A one-time fee of \$30 will apply for each additional person and for each additional vehicle. For families, 2 children under 12 accompanying parents are included in the camping fee rate. Children must also have wristbands. **The health department mandates no more than one camping unit per site and no more than 8 people per site.**
6. Race reservation rates are for 7 day, 6 night stay. Check in starts noon Tuesday before the race and check-out Monday after the race.
7. ***There are no refunds within 30 days of the race, no exceptions!***
8. There are no company promotions, giving out flyers/ business cards or showing/selling products, including tickets, from any camping site. A vendor site must be purchased for any of these activities.
9. Children are the responsibility of their parents or guardians. No one under 12 years of age is allowed in the pond area or playground without direct adult supervision.
10. Swimming and boating are not allowed.
11. Speed limit is 10 mph throughout the campground. Driving around in the campground is prohibited except to access your site. Passengers must ride inside of vehicles. No riding in truck beds or on a vehicle in other than a seat designed for that purpose.
12. You may not damage camp property. This includes picnic tables, signs, site markers, buildings and their furnishings, vegetation, porta johns, etc. Climbing, cutting, posting signs, cables or nails on trees is also prohibited.
13. All fires must be kept reasonable and attended to at all time. No skids or scrap lumber is to be used for firewood because of nails. Downed dead branches may be gathered and used. No chain saws may be used. Firewood may be brought in, but you cannot take it out due to the Level 1 Quarantine in our area for the Emerald Ash Borer.
14. No rubbish is to be burned. It must be put in plastic bags and placed in dumpsters. You may not burn couches or other household items – FIREWOOD ONLY.
15. Use of firearms, BB guns, Slingshots, water pistols/guns/canons of any type, spotlights, laser pointers or FIREWORKS is not permitted. Use of these WILL result in immediate eviction. Water is limited to use for personal consumption and hygiene. Putting water in truck beds, pools, skids, large barrels and the like is prohibited.
16. If you are not on an electrical/water site do not run cords/hose to access these amenities.
17. Motorized recreational vehicles such as Mopeds, cycles, golf carts, off road or ATV vehicles are prohibited on Juniper Hills property during NASCAR events.
18. Quiet Time is from 12:00 AM. until 8:00 AM. Generators must also be shut off at this time. The playing of loud music, use of large speakers, or causing of excessive noise is prohibited at all times and may result in eviction.
19. No lewd, obscene, or other offensive conduct, products or signage is permitted.
20. Violation of camp rules or failure to comply with requests by Security Personnel may result in eviction with no refund. Camp rules may be changed. Changes will be posted in the store, and are available upon request.
21. You may not transfer or sublet any lots without management approval.
22. Cans and bottles discarded on the ground or in trash bins cannot be collected without prior written approval from Juniper Hills.
23. To reserve the same site, you must make your reservation within 30 days of the end of the race. We do not automatically make your reservation for you. You may request a change of sites after the dates above.
24. To assure the enjoyment and safety of all, you must follow all campground rules, interpretations made by campground security personnel.
25. Juniper Hills is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen property.
26. **Anyone camping for the race in a site in the "20 Acre Woods"/Pavilion area needs to be aware that if a person picks that particular site for a seasonal site the race campers will be moved to a comparable site.**
27. Any violation of these rules is subject to eviction from the campgrounds without a refund.
